KNB Adopt-a-Highway clean-up this Saturday

Volunteers are needed to assist Keep Noblesville Beautiful during the Adopt-a-Highway clean-up 9 a.m. to noon Saturday on Indiana 37 from Indiana 32 north to 195th Street.

Volunteers will meet in the parking lot of Our Lady of Grace Church on the northwest corner of Ind. 37 and 191st Street to distribute safety vests and trash bags. Workers should wear good footwear and bring their own gloves. Cell phones will also be useful.

Participants will be asked to sign a waiver form prior to the clean-up and volunteers between the ages of 12 and 18 must have an adult sign the waiver for them.

No volunteers under the age of 12 are asked to participate in this project.

Only the shoulder areas will be cleaned, the Indiana Department of Transportation will clean the medians on another date. By joining the Adopt a Highway program, KNB commits to cleaning the area at least four times a year between the months of April and October.
